2 lines space

Begin the abstract text in typeface 12 points with 1.5 line distance (style normal)

Abstract submission : 25 September 2007

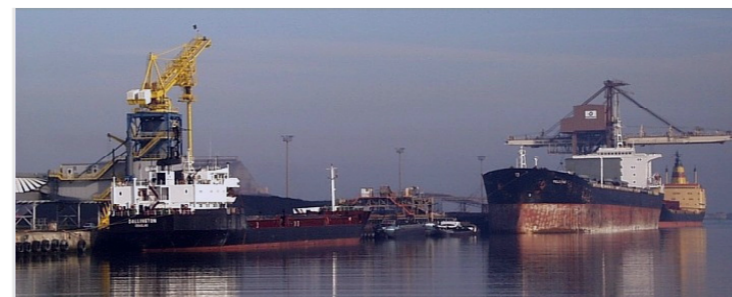
Notification of review results: 15 December 2007
